

What is Families READ?

Families READ is an adult education program that strives to enable each adult to reach their academic, career, and parenting goals, while simultaneously offering a quality early childhood literacy program that assists parents in preparing their child for school.

Families READ commits to families by providing:

- Bimonthly Friday discovery and parent education groups
- Opportunities and materials for PACT (Parent and Child Together) Time
- Opportunities for parents to prepare their child for school through reading and playtime
- One-to-one weekly goal setting and support meetings with the Literacy Coordinator

Families commit to Families READ by:

- Attending classes to complete coursework for their diploma, HISET, or college credits
- Reading to their child
- Attending and participating in Friday discovery groups, parent education group, and weekly support meetings
- Completing at least two PACT activities with their child each week

Families READ works with agencies like DHHS to help participants find financial assistance for:

- Transportation to/from classes, tutoring, and Families READ activities
- Classes and Books
- Childcare
